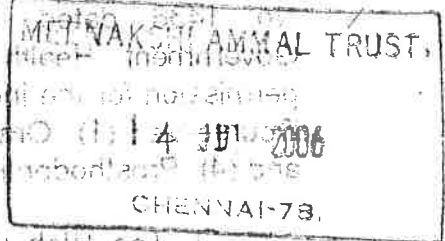

The Government is hereby granting the desirability and feasibility of the Permission / Essentiality Certificate to Meenakshi Ammal Trust to increase the intake of seats in Postgraduate courses at Meenakshi Ammal Dental College, Maduravoyal, Chennai in the following Specialities:

2. The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the Inspection Report along with her specific recommendation. The Government have



examined the request of the Meenakshi Ammal Trust based on the Inspection Report and issued rejection orders vide, Letter (D) No. 1438, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated, 23.12.2004 by pointing out certain deficiencies.

3. Against the above rejection order, the Managing Trustee, Meenakshi Ammal Trust has filed W.P. No. 3479 of 2005 with a prayer to quash Letter (D) No. 1438, dated, 23.12.2004 and consequently direct the Secretary to Government, Health and Family Welfare Department to issue a requisite permission for the increased admission capacity in various discipline of MDS Course viz., (1) Oral Surgery, (2) Orthodontics, (3) Conservative Dentistry and (4) Prosthodontics of the petitioner College.

4. The High Court of Madras in its order dated 22.11.2005 among other things, quashed the impugned Proceedings dated 23.12.2004 passed by the Secretary to Government, Health and Family Welfare Department and consequently directed the respondents to pass necessary orders on the application of the petitioner seeking to increase the intake of seats in MDS course prospectively within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. In the meantime, Meenakshi Ammal Trust has filed Contempt Petition No. 135 of 2006 before the High Court of Madras.

The Government have examined the case in pursuance of the directions of the High Court of Madras dated 22.11.2005 in W.P. No. 3479 of 2005 and W.P.M.P. No. 3920 of 2005 and based on the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education, so as to avoid Contempt Proceedings.

7. The Government after verifying the desirability and feasibility convey the Permission / Essentiality Certificate to Meenakshi Ammal Trust to increase the intake of MDS seats as detailed below, subject to approval of the Dental Council of India / Government of India before the students are admitted.

Sub: Dental Education – Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research – Request for issue of Essentiality Certificate to start MDS Degree Course in the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry at Meenakshi Ammal Dental College – Orders Issued.

Ref: 1. G.O. (Ms.) No. 30, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated, 21.2.2006.

2. From the Registrar, Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research, representation, dated, 15.5.2006.

The Registrar, Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research (Deemed University) has requested the Government to issue essentiality certificate to Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital for approaching the Central Government and Dental Council of India for permission to start the MDS Course in Preventive and Community Dentistry.

2. The Director of Medical Education was requested to make necessary arrangement for causing inspection of Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital, Maduravoyal with reference to the norms of Dental Council of India to start MDS Course in the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry

and submit her report in the tabular form along with her specific recommendation.

3. In the meantime, the Registrar, Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research has filed W.P. No. 36955 of 2005 and W.P.M.P. No. 39597 of 2005 before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras with a prayer to direct the first respondent i.e., Secretary to Government, Health and Family Welfare Department to issue a requisite permission or Essentiality Certificate to start the MDS Degree Course in the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry at Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital at Maduravoyal, Chennai. The Hon'ble High Court of Madras in its order dated, 16.11.2005 in the above Writ Petition has directed to pass appropriate orders on the application of the Petitioner

4. In pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, dated, 16.11.2005, the Government have examined the connected records with reference to the Dental Council of India norms. In the Teaching Faculty, there is no Staff in the category of Assistant Professor. The applicant Deemed University has not produced the following documents:-

(a) Clearance Certificate under Section 37 (B) of the Tamil Nadu Land Reforms Act, 1961.

(b) Approved Plans for the Buildings.

5. In view of deficiencies pointed out in para 4 above, the Government have considered that there is no feasibility and desirability for starting MDS Courses in the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry at Meenakshi Ammal Dental College. Hence, the request of Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research to issue Essentiality Certificate to start MDS Degree Course in the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry at Meenakshi Ammal Dental College, Maduravoyal was rejected (vide G.O. (Ms.) No. 30, dated, 21.2.2006).

6. The Registrar, Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research has submitted a Compliance Report stating that sufficient Staff have been appointed and that they have applied to the competent authorities for clearance under section 37 (B) of the Tamil Nadu Land Reforms Act, 1961 and Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority for building approval.

7. The Registrar, Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research has also reported that Meenakshi Ammal Dental College is already conducting MDS Course in various Specialities and as the present proposal to start the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry in MDS course is only an additional programme and as they have already fully satisfied the norms of the Dental Council of India at substantial cost. The Registrar has

therefore, requested the Government of Tamil Nadu to kindly reconsider the matter based on the Inspection Report submitted by the Director of Medical Education on 18.12.2004 to the Government and issue the No Objection Certificate, (i.e.) the Essentiality Certificate to start the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry in MDS Course at the above College with an admission capacity of three students.

8. The Government have examined the case with connected records. This Institute is already running Postgraduate Courses in Dental subjects. They seek Essentiality Certificate for an additional Course viz., MDS in Preventive and Community Dentistry.

9. The Government after verifying the desirability and feasibility, convey the permission / Essentiality Certificate to the Registrar, Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education to start MDS Degree Course in the Speciality of Preventive and Community Dentistry at Meenakshi Ammal Dental College at an annual intake of three students, subject to the approval of the Dental Council of India / Government of India before the students are admitted.


